Workshop called to order.
Chief Green led the assemblage in the Pledge of Allegiance

The purpose of the workshop was to meet with representatives of the Liz Loomis Public Affairs firm, a business that conducts public education projects for agencies considering taking tax measures before the electorate.

Liz Loomis and Alison Peters of Alison Peters Consulting gave presentations explaining the history of their operations and the methods they would propose to use to assist Fire District 6 in conducting a public education program.

Estimated costs for polling were between \$25,000 to \$30,000 and for a strategic communications plan between \$15,000 and \$18,000.


Costs for conducting a public education plan could vary, depending on what the District could do to help hold costs down.

The Board indicated it would like to consider contracting with Loomis and Peters and each will submit contracts outlining their proposal and associated costs for the Board to take under advisement at a future Board meeting.
