TESTING ANNOUNCEMENT FOR ENTRY-LEVEL FIREFIGHTER

September 1, 2014

Fire District 6 is establishing an 18 month firefighter eligibility list with the intent to hire during the duration of the list.

Successful recruits will be sent to the Washington State Fire Training Academy. Fire District 6 also participates in the Washington State Firefighters Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee (JATC) program. All line personnel are members of [IAFF Local 1805](#).

Application & Written Test

Clark County Fire District 6 utilizes the services of Public Safety Testing for application and written exams for all entry level firefighter/EMT and firefighter/paramedic candidates. Interested candidates should visit [Public Safety Testing \(www.publicsafetytesting.com\)](http://www.publicsafetytesting.com) or call 866-HIRE-911 to create an account and apply on-line for Clark County Fire District 6.

In order for your written score to be available to Fire District 6, you must have completed your written exam with Public Safety Testing between February 27, 2014 and by October 1, 2014 at 5:00 PM. **The deadline to complete your written exam and apply is October 1, 2014 at 5:00 PM.** Candidates have several opportunities to take the written exam including an opportunity in Vancouver, WA on September 14, 2014. See the PST calendar for details.

Physical Abilities Test

You must possess valid Candidate Physical Abilities Test (CPAT) credentials dated between October 1, 2013 and October 1, 2014 and present it to Clark County Fire District 6 no later than 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, October 1, 2014. You may do so in person OR via email (nancy.olschewsky@ccfd6.org) OR via FAX 360.576.1198. Any legitimate CPAT will suffice. CPAT Orientation and Practice Tests are recommended and available prior to the deadline.

CPAT tests are conducted by Public Safety Testing and National Testing Network (NTN). Contact PST at www.publicsafetytesting.com or NTN at www.nationaltestingnetwork.com for available tests.

Personal History Statement (PHS)

A completed Personal History Statement (PHS) must be uploaded to your account prior to Friday, October 24th at 5:00 PM. To complete or upload your PHS, login to [your account](#) and navigate to "My PHS Form".
