A RESOLUTION OF CLARK COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT 6 PROVIDING AUTHORIZATION TO INVOICE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS SPILLERS AND AT FAULT PARTIES FOR COST RECOVERY EFFORTS PERTAINING TO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS RESPONSE, MOTOR VEHICLE INCIDENTS, AND RELATED SERVICES RENDERED BY CLARK COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT 6.

WHEREAS, the Board of Clark County Fire District 6 finds it necessary to authorize Clark County Fire District 6 to respond to and control hazardous material spills from motor vehicle collisions and other defined hazardous materials incidents, and when deemed necessary and appropriate, recover the costs of cleanup from responsible parties; and


WHEREAS, the expense of responding to and mitigating hazardous material spills and motor vehicle accidents should be borne by the responsible parties and not the citizens of and taxpayers residing within the Clark County Fire District response area; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Clark County Fire District 6 has adopted a policy for the use of equipment, personnel and consumable products at incidents, and to identify the procedure for the recovery of costs associated with the use of such equipment, personnel and consumable products at appropriate incidents; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Clark County Fire District 6 have determined that it is necessary to establish such authorization and procedures to preserve the health, safety and welfare of citizens and taxpayers that reside within the Clark County Fire District 6 response area;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Clark County Fire District 6 authorizes cost recovery efforts for Clark County Fire District 6, along with administrative fees for collection actions taken in these efforts.


