**RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT AN EMS LEVY  
(Primary Election)**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLARK COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 6 PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE DISTRICT AT THE SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD WITHIN THE DISTRICT ON AUGUST 2, 2016 IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE STATE PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE, OF A PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING THE UNINTERRUPTED CONTINUATION OF AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROPERTY TAX LEVY NOT TO EXCEED \$.45 PER \$1,000.00 OF TRUE AND ASSESSED VALUATION, IN ADDITION TO ITS REGULAR PROPERTY TAX LEVY, FOR A PERIOD OF SIX CONSECUTIVE YEARS BEGINNING IN 2016 AND ENDING IN 2021 AND TO BE COLLECTED IN EACH SUCCEEDING YEAR TO PROVIDE FUNDS REQUIRED BY THE DISTRICT TO ENABLE THE DISTRICT TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

**Background:** WHEREAS, the District voters approved a six-year \$.45 EMS levy in 2010 that will expire on December 31, 2016.

WHEREAS, it is the judgment of the Board of Commissioners of the District that it is essential and necessary for the protection of the health and life of the residents of the District that emergency medical services be provided by the District and that the EMS levy be continued for an additional six years.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners have determined that such services will necessitate the expenditure of revenues for maintenance, operations, equipment and personnel in excess of those which can be provided by the District's regular tax levy for collection over the next six years;

**Resolution:** NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Clark County Fire Protection District No. 6, Clark County, Washington as follows:

**Section 1.** In order to provide emergency medical services, it is necessary that the District perform the following functions:

- 1.1. Obtain, operate and maintain emergency medical vehicles and facilities staffed by properly trained emergency medical technicians, paramedics and/or other medically trained personnel.
- 1.2. Obtain consumable medical supplies and medical appliances to equip such emergency vehicles, personnel, and facilities.
- 1.3. Maintain and/or improve existing response levels to EMS emergencies with qualified personnel when available.

**Section 2.** In order to provide the revenue adequate to pay the costs of providing emergency medical services and facilities as described in Section I and to maintain reserve funds sufficient to assure the continuation of such services, the District shall renew its expiring EMS levy and levy each year for a period of six consecutive years beginning in 2016 and collect each year for a

period of six consecutive years, beginning in 2017, a general tax on taxable property within the District, in addition to the fire levy for maintenance and operation costs, in an amount not to exceed \$.45 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation of such property.

**Section 3.** In accordance with RCW 84.52.069 the funds raised by such levy shall be used only for the provision of emergency medical services, including related personnel costs, service contract costs, training for such personnel, and related equipment, supplies, vehicles and structures needed for the provision of emergency medical services.

**Section 5.** There shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the District for their ratification or rejection, at the special election on August 2, 2016, in conjunction with the state primary election to be held on the same date, the question of whether or not such levy for emergency medical services shall be made each year for a period of six consecutive years, the first levy to be made in 2016 and to be collected in 2017. The Board of Commissioners hereby requests the auditor of Clark County, as ex-officio Supervisor of Elections to call such election and to submit the following proposition at such election, in the form of a ballot title substantially as follows:



Clark County Fire Protection District No. 6 - Board of Commissioners – Proposition authorizing and continuing regular emergency medical services property tax levy.

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
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

(Emergency Medical Services Tax Levy Continuation)

BALLOT ISSUE EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

In 2010 Clark County Fire Protection District No. 6 voters approved a 6-year \$.45 Emergency Medical Service "EMS" Levy. The 2010 EMS levy will expire at the end of this year unless the voters approve this measure. If approved by the voters, this measure will authorize Clark County Fire Protection District No. 6 to continue for another six years its EMS property tax levy at a rate not to exceed \$0.45 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation.

Approval of the levy will allow the District to continue to maintain and improve the level of emergency medical services within the District.
