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#### 1. Nature and Purpose

**1.1.** This position is one of several in Clark County Fire District 6, whose mission is, *"Dedicated to Excellence in Protecting and Serving our Community."* The primary purpose of this position is to prevent costly breakdowns and to ensure operational readiness of the fleet and equipment required to meet that mission. Under supervision, this position provides on-going servicing, maintenance and repair of District apparatus, tools, and equipment.

**1.2.** The Mechanic position is separated into 5 distinct levels based on time in grade, training, and education. To advance to the successive level, the employee must meet all the requirements of the prior level.

**1.3.** The expectation is that the employee will achieve Step V Mechanic in 3 to 5 years.

#### 2. Position Requirements

##### 2.1. Step I Mechanic

Unless otherwise noted, completion of each requirement below is necessary to complete the probationary period and advance to Step II Mechanic.

2.1.1. State of Washington Class A CDL within 3 months of entering the Mechanic Classification

2.1.2. Must provide and maintain an industry standard set of tools on site within 3 months of entering the Mechanic Classification.

2.1.3. Completion of District assigned training.

- 2.1.4. ASE Certification in the following
  - 2.1.4.1. T1 Truck, Gasoline Engines
  - 2.1.4.2. T2 Truck, Diesel Engines
  - 2.1.4.3. T3 Truck, Drive Train
  - 2.1.4.4. T4 Truck, Brakes
  - 2.1.4.5. T5, Truck Suspension and Steering
  - 2.1.4.6. T6, Truck, Electrical Systems
  - 2.1.4.7. T7 Heating/Vent/Air Conditioning
  - 2.1.4.8. T8 PMI (Preventative Maintenance Inspection)
- 2.1.5. Competency in District communication systems and software.
- 2.1.6. Familiarity with District policies, rules and regulations as contained in the Employee Handbook.
- 2.1.7. Completion of 1 year of service.

## **2.2. Step II Mechanic**

Completion of each requirement in this section is required to advance to Step III Mechanic.

- 2.2.1. Achieve Emergency Vehicle Fire Apparatus Technician Level 1
- 2.2.2. Completion of at least 1 year of service in the current grade.

## **2.3. Step III Mechanic**

Completion of each requirement in this section is required to advance to Step IV Mechanic.

- 2.3.1. Achieve Emergency Vehicle Fire Apparatus Technician Level 2
- 2.3.2. Completion of at least 1 year of service in the current grade.

## **2.4. Step IV Mechanic**

Completion of each requirement in this section is required to advance to Step V Mechanic.

- 2.4.1. Achieve Emergency Vehicle Fire Apparatus Master Technician
- 2.4.2. Completion of at least 1 year of service in the current grade.
