**RESOLUTION No. 2022-09**

**ONE PERCENT INCREASE IN PROPERTY TAX**

**WHEREAS** Clark County Fire Protection District No. 6 has properly given notice of the public hearing held November 2, 2022, to consider the Clark County Fire Protection District No. 6 expense budget for 2023, pursuant to RCW 84.55.120; and

**WHEREAS** Clark County Fire Protection District No. 6, after hearing, and after duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, has determined that Clark County Fire Protection District No. 6 requires an increase in the property tax levy from the previous year; and


**WHEREAS** the population of the District is more than 10,000; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Clark County Fire Protection District No. 6 that an increase in the property tax levy is hereby authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2023 tax year. The dollar amount of the increase over the actual levy amount from the previous year shall be \$158,543.59, which is a percentage increase of 1.0% from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbines, solar, biomass and geothermal facilities, and any increase in the value of state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.
